

Hannibal Piecemakers 2019 Challenges

July Challenge – Bucket List



Rules: Have fun and share with us something on your bucket list. It can be something you already did or dream of doing.

Don't have a bucket list? Choose anything with a "bucket" that has a special meaning to you – Child's toy - sand bucket, garden, milk bucket, an interpretation of a phrase including the word bucket such as a bucket full of ? – just a drop in the bucket – can't carry a tune in a bucket – rusty bucket etc.

Bucket should be visible on the quilt, label or mentioned in the name.

3 x 5 card with a write-up explaining how your interpretation relates to you personally must be displayed/pinned to the front of your entry. (This information may be used on the 2020 HPQG quilt show label)

Quilt may be started before 2019 but must be FINISHED in 2019.

Quilt may be any size and must be 2-3 layers. No bags or clothing please. Quilt must include some piecing and quilting. Piecing/quilting may be any technique. Finished Edge does not have to be bound traditionally. Embellishments are optional.

Quilt back must include a hanging sleeve and label made according to the guidelines of the 2020 quilt show rules.

Entries should be kept secret. Please cover up your label with a piece of paper or fabric before handing it in to the program committee at the meeting.

Due Date: Finished challenges are due at our July 2019 meeting.

December Challenge – "It's a Small World"

Rules: Your creation can either be traditional or contemporary. It must include some interpretation of the word "world". It could be the shape, traditional blocks with the name world (Trip Around the World, World's Fair Puzzle, Worlds Without End, etc), a child's quilt, somewhere you traveled, or a theme such as Color my World - You mean the world to me – What in the world? – Brighten my World – My whole world, etc.

Each participant will choose 2 random crayons. To correspond with the 2020 HPQG quilt show theme "Color My World" you are required to use 1 or both crayon colors in your entry.

Crayon must be displayed on 3 x 5 card pinned to the front of your entry with a brief story about your quilt. (This information may be used on the 2020 HPQG quilt show label).

Quilt may be started before 2019 but must be FINISHED in 2019.

Quilt may be any size and must be 2-3 layers. No bags or clothing please. Quilt must include some piecing and quilting. Piecing/quilting may be any technique. Finished Edge does not have to be bound traditionally. Embellishments are optional.

Quilt back must include a hanging sleeve and label made according to the guidelines of the 2020 quilt show rules.

Entries should be kept secret. Please cover up your label with a piece of paper or fabric before handing it in to the program committee at the meeting.
