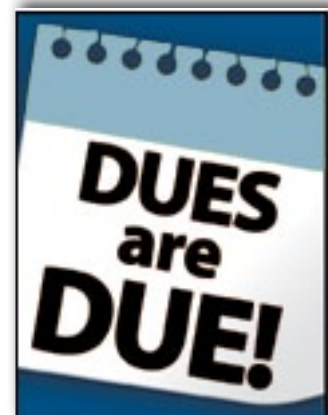

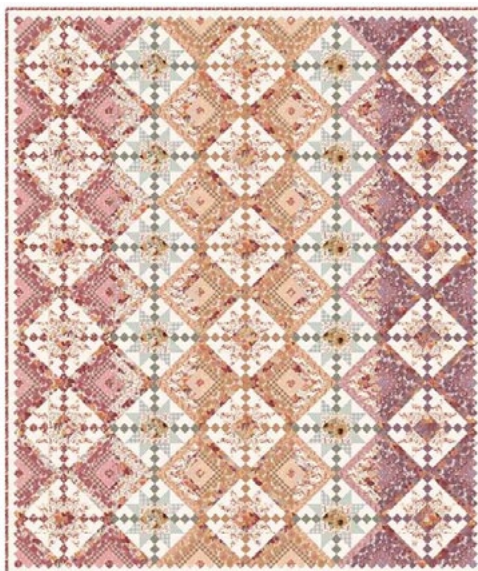

We will try this again! Project will be making Potato Chip Blocks. Each block is made of 18 fabric



pieces that are 2½" x 4½". I will have many printed quilt ideas of how to place your pieces in the block to make unique quilts. You can choose from them or make your own design. So bring lots of 2½" by 4½" fabric pieces in lights, mediums and darks! If you don't want to work on this project you can always bring something else to work on and enjoy sewing with fellow quilters.
