We will be doing Twilight Bayou by Moonkin Stitchery. You will be making two blocks, one a regular 9 patch and the other will be a star nine patch. You will need 168 - 5" blocks and one yard of fabric for background stars. Cut your background into 12 - 5" blocks and 96 - 2¾" blocks, you can use a solid or a dark print, so the star stands out from the nine patches. Come and have a fun day of sewing on this project or something else. Bring your lunch or go out and pick up something. If you have an idea and would like to teach a workshop some month, let me know and we can work it into the schedule. -- Sue Winking



**2026 SERIES QUILT — LAURA'S LOG CABIN BY MODERN PRAIRIE**  
*The labeled & color-coded chart on Page 13 is very helpful for understanding block & color placement.*

February: Cutting the fabric. Be sure to use the fabric labels we have provided. There is a LOT of cutting! Please note there is NO S2. There is an S1 and an S3.

**March:** A portion of the Star Blocks. We will be completing all instructions on page 5 (Steps 1-9) of the pattern. Scant ¼” seams are used for construction.



- Make 12 Corner 1A units
- Make 12 Corner 1B units
- Make 24 Corner 2A units
- Make 24 Corner 2B units
- Make 12 Corner 3A units
- Make 12 Corner 3B units
- Make 12 Corner 4A units
- Make 12 Corner 4B Units

If anyone needs a paper copy of the fabric labels, schedule for the year, or other documents, please let us know. There are links to each document on the HPQG facebook page, but we can get paper copies for members if that is needed.



# “Echoes” 2026 QOV National Block

10” finished (10 ½” unfinished)

Use only red, white (cream) and blue fabrics. Please DO NOT use floral fabrics. The center block is a great opportunity to incorporate those medium and large prints (including branch specific) that attract the eye. If choosing branch specific, represent only one military branch per block. The reds and blues to the upper left and lower right corners of the blocks should read as solids, only very small prints will work here. The whites and creams should also read as solids; prints larger than a pin dot are too overwhelming to the rest of the block.




## Block One

Center: 1-5 ½” focus square (A)

Blue: 2-3” X 5 ½” rectangles (B), 2-3” squares (C)

White: 2-3” squares (D), 2-3” X 5 ½” rectangles (E)



## Block Two


Center: 1-5 ½” square (A)

Red: 2-3” X 5 ½” rectangles (B), 2-3” squares (C)


White: 2-3” squares (D), 2-3” x 5 ½” rectangles (E)

Sewing instructions are the same for Blocks 1, 2, and 3.

1. Sew one C to one D. Repeat for the other C and D.
2. Sew one B to one E. Repeat for the other B and E.
3. Sew units together as shown. Follow arrows for pressing.
