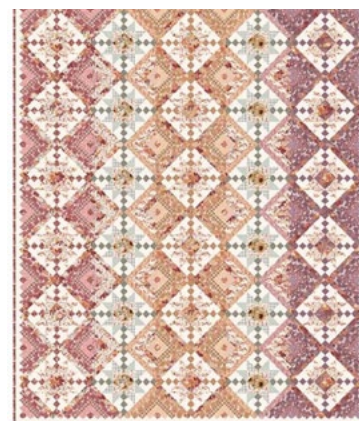

2026 SERIES QUILT — LAURA'S LOG CABIN BY MODERN PRAIRIE

The labeled & color-coded chart on Page 13 is very helpful for understanding block & color placement.

March Assignment: Complete a portion of the Star Blocks. Stitch the blocks outlined on page 5 (Steps 1-9) of the pattern. Scant 1/4" seams are used for construction. Bring these to the April guild meeting.



April Assignment: Complete the Quarter Square Triangles for the Star Blocks. Bring these to the May guild meeting. Page 6, steps 10-16.

- 72 total W1/W3 triangles
- 72 total W2/W3 triangles
- Use the above units to make 72 Quarter Square Triangle 1 Units. Trim to 4 1/4" square.
- 48 total W1/W5 triangles
- 48 total W2/W4 triangles
- Use the 48 count units to make 48 Quarter Square Triangle 2 Units. Trim to 4 1/4" square.

**APRIL 18 WORKSHOP
TIPSY BASKETS -- SUE WINKING**

Beacon United Methodist Church 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.

We will be doing Tipsy Baskets from Scrap-Basket Sensations by Kim Brackett.

You will need:

- 30 -- 2½” by 42” strips of assorted light prints for blocks
- 20 -- 2½” by 42” strips of assorted dark prints for blocks
- 1½ yards of large scale print for outer border
- ½ yard for inner border

Finished quilt is 53½” by 61½”

Finished blocks are 8” by 8”.

If you want to cut up your strips before the workshop so you can get sewing, you may do so.

From **each** 30 light prints cut:

2 rectangles, 2½” by 6½” (60 total)

7 squares, 2½” by 2½” (210 total)

From **each** of **10** dark prints cut:

2 rectangles, 2½” by 6½” (20 total)

2 rectangles, 2½” by 4½” (20 total)

5 squares 2½” x 2½” (50 total)

From **each** of the **10** remaining dark prints, cut:

1 rectangle, 2½” by 6½” (10 total)

1 rectangle 2½” by 4½” (10 total)

7 squares, 2½” x 2½” (70 total)

You will be making 30 blocks.

If you want to come, but work on another project, that is fine. We usually bring our lunch, but you can go out and get something and eat with us or eat out.

If anyone is interested in teaching a project some month, let me know and we can work it into the schedule. -- Sue

HPQG 2025 PHD MONTHLY CHALLENGE

A PHD (Project half done) is a project you have started and not finished. Your PHD must at least still need to be quilted, bound and labeled (attaching a binding only will NOT be accepted as part of the challenge). **Projects must be started at least 2 years ago or older.**

Finished items will allow you to be put into a draw to win a PRIZE.

Table runner sets, small/medium wall hanging etc. = 1 draw Large projects = 2 draws

The more projects finished the more chances to win. Winners will be announced at the November 3, 2026 meeting. Members do not have to be present to win.
